

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS TO CARRY OUT A LEGAL WEDDING UNDER THE MEXICAN LAWS

- Official identification (official id or passport).
- Copy of birth certificate of the parties and a copy of the CURP (for Mexicans).
- Wedding format (this format will be sent to you by the Wedding Coordination team, which must be duly completed and signed).
- Tourist cards which will be received upon arrival in Mexico (in the case of foreigners) Please fill it out properly according to the information in your passport.
- Cover the expenses of legal procedures, please consult with Sales Executive or Wedding Coordinator.
- A blood test is required which must be done in Cozumel, the Wedding Coordination team will schedule the appointment. The price of this exam is **\$200USD** which must be paid directly to the wedding coordinator. Price subject to change without notice.
- (4) four witnesses, the couple will have 2 witnesses each who must provide an official identification (passport or official id) to be a witness must be of legal age (18 years). They will be together with the parties in the ceremony for signing documents at the time of making the link.
- **Hotel employees can act as witnesses; You will have an additional cost per witness, please check with the hotel.**
- Translation of birth certificates or divorced documents (if divorced) has additional cost. Consult with the hotel's coordination team.

The documents must be translated by a Certified Official Translator to certify said documents.

- The marriage certificate will be delivered by the Mexican Government in Spanish (due to the nationality of the country where they are contracting nuptials). You can request the translation of the Marriage License (after the wedding) for an additional price.

Important:

- All documentation must be delivered to the Wedding Coordination team at least 3 business days before the wedding, this to carry out all the formalities required by the Civil Registry. The contracting parties must arrive at the hotel at least 4 business days before the wedding date.
- The legal documents are your responsibility so you should check that everything meets the above requirements. Any document that presents a writing error can lead to the cancellation of the wedding, in which case the hotel cannot be held responsible.
- Laws and requirements, as well as costs of legal proceedings may be subject to change without prior notice.

A civil wedding under Mexican law can be recognized internationally, please check with the civil registry of your state or province the procedure required to legalize your marriage.

Please consider the following information before confirming your legal wedding:

- ** All documents delivered to the Wedding Coordination team to carry out your wedding will become property of the state of Quintana Roo, Mexico.
- ** Links made on Saturday, will have the date of Friday; In case it is a holiday, the date will be according to the next business day.
- ** Laws, as well as prices are subject to change without notice.
- ** Legal weddings can only take place from Monday to Saturday. For special dates and holidays, as well as Sundays, please check with your wedding coordinator for their viability.
