

Required Documents for weddings with the JUDGE
(Civil ceremony) for Weddings in Mexico.

- VALID Passports
- (Although passports are not required for US Citizens for entry into Mexico, they are mandatory for weddings)
- Wedding Form Information (This form will be send by the wedding coordinator and need to be returned with all the information filled ASAP)
- Tourist cards received upon arrival in Mexico (Make sure you fill the same: Name, Middle name and Last name. The Information has to match with the Passport **(Very Important)**).
- Legal fees: **500 usd**
- Blood Test (Blood test has to be done in Cozumel, the extra charge is **\$200.00 USD**. For the couple (payable directly to the wedding coordinator, we will coordinate an appointment for the blood test)
- (4) Four witnesses with picture ID and tourist card (In a legal wedding with a Judge you will need 4 witnesses in total (2 for the bride and 2 for the groom). A witness must be over the age of 18. They will need to stand up with the wedding couple during the wedding ceremony and sign some documents, It is recommended that you select people from your wedding party)
- **Our employees can serve as witnesses at an extra charge of 25 USD each.**
- Translation of the Birth Certificates or Divorced Documents (if divorced): 50.00 USD per document. Documents need to be translated by an Official Translator in Cozumel
- Translation of the Marriage License “ Optional” (after you get married) 50.00 USD
- Marriage certificate will be given by the Mexican Government and it will be in Spanish as it is our natural language.

Please Note:

- All necessary paperwork is handled directly by your Wedding Coordinator. In order to complete all the formalities we require a minimum of three business days. Bride, Groom and witnesses are required to arrive to the **Occidental Cozumel** 3 business days prior to the ceremony day.
- The legal requirements are your responsibility, It is important that you check all documentation thoroughly as any mistakes such as incorrect spelling of names (Tourist Cards) etc. may lead to the cancellation of your wedding, for which **Occidental Cozumel** cannot be held responsible.
- Laws and requirements are subject to change with accordance of the laws of Mexico.

Please note:

A Civil wedding in Mexico is recognized internationally however, before coming to Mexico, check with your State or Province on how to register your Mexican Wedding. Each State and County has different requirements and it is your responsibility to verify what you need to register your license in your country. Let us know if you will need a translated copy of your marriage license, since your license will be in Spanish. We can have it translated by our certified translator for a charge

- Saturday weddings: Due to the civil office being closed on Saturdays, your license will be dated the previous business day (Friday or if it is a holiday, the day before).
