

## Information for Civil ( Legal) Ceremony:

### Civil Wedding

- All Civil weddings take place at the Town Hall in Oranjestad

### Includes:

- Local documentation handling on your behalf
- Registration fee, civil fees and administration fees
- Translation of wedding certificate
- Authentication of translation ( legalization – Apostille)
- Coordination and handling fees for the civil part of your wedding
- Transfer 2 way from the Resort/Civil for the couple
- Meet and Greet prior to the wedding date

### Requirements:

1. Completed Aruba Declaration of intent to marry, completed and signed individually ( this document will be send to you by us)
2. Completed Aruba Declaration of Single Status, completed and signed individually ( this document will be send to you by us)
3. LONG FORM Birth Certificate of each with both names of the parents on it
4. Official Death Certificate(s) of previous spouse(s), if widowed
5. Divorce Certificate, if divorced **OR** Official Divorce Degree of previous spouse(s), if divorced (first and last page)
6. Negative Statement of Marriage **OR** Affidavit of Single Status. This certificate of no impediment is obtained at the bureau of vital statistics which is located in the department of health (department of Commonwealth). **OR, if never been married** A sworn statement can be made before a consular official, Lawyer
7. Copy of Valid Passport picture pages of the bride and Groom to be
8. Copy of Valid Passport picture pages of Two Witnesses, (minimum 18 years of age) (minimum 2 witnesses , Maximum 4 witnesses)
9. Document under the number **3,4,5** and **6** must be furnished with an **Apostille** from the Secretary of State Office or Bureau of Vital Statistics (USA) or the Department (Ministries) of Foreign Affairs (UK), or the Dutch Embassy (for Canada, Venezuela, Colombia, Peru, Dominican Republic and other countries) or for **Canada** at a Consulate General. This is to state authenticity, **do not confuse with a Raised Seal**. It is a separate document which they will attach to the original Birth Certificate, Death Certificate, Divorce degrees and the Single Status Report
10. **All documents must be first scanned and emailed to: [e2arubaevents@gmail.com](mailto:e2arubaevents@gmail.com)**  
OR [edwina.werleman@gmail.com](mailto:edwina.werleman@gmail.com) , for review minimum 6 weeks prior to Wedding Date, then after approval, all original document must be send with **FedEx** to the below address. The original documents must be submitted at least 16 work days before wedding date according to the Dutch Law
